The Independent Student Coalition for the International Criminal Court (the ISC-ICC) is the only nationwide not-for-profit, non-governmental student organization in the United States working solely to educate the American public about the International Criminal Court (ICC). While we are members of the Washington Working Group for the ICC (WICC), the American NGO Coalition for the ICC (AMICC), and the International NGO Coalition for the ICC (CICC), we remain an independent organization pursuing our own activities. The primary functions of the ISC-ICC are to raise American public awareness of the ICC through academia and scholarship, to dispel myths about the Court circulated by its critics, and to ensure eventual US cooperation with and participation in the workings of the Court.

The work of the Coalition is done through its Liaisons in local communities around the country. There are currently over 30 such Liaisons in the United States. Liaisons work in their local communities to educate the public about the issues related to the ICC.
